S3 INFORMATION APRIL/MAY 2018

This letter is to inform you of several events that are occurring in the coming weeks in respect of S3 pupils, namely S3 assessments, the issuing of S3 profiles and the end of year S3 progress report.

S3 Assessment

During the weeks from w/c 30 April to w/c 21 May 2018, we have organised a diet of S3 assessments for S3 pupils. The information gleaned is seen as useful by pupils, parents and teachers in measuring progress towards National Qualifications in the following year. We believe that within the Curriculum for Excellence programme it is still important that there is some degree of assessment to give an indication of present and future progress. Different subject departments will have different assessment tools that they may use to measure progress towards the National Qualifications (National 3, 4, 5). Overleaf we have detailed when each subject area will assess S3 pupils. The result of these assessments will inform the S3 report and will provide a broad indication of future progress. Also, as in previous years, it will be the result of the prelim examinations in S4 which will also help determine the level of presentation in the final exams.

S3 Profiles

Over the next few weeks, all S3 pupils will be creating a personal profile outlining their experiences and achievements in the S1 to S3 period. A copy of these profiles are kept with your child's guidance teacher in school and a copy will be coming home with your child during May 2018. The profile covers all 8 curricular areas of Curriculum for Excellence as well as personal statements around learning, skills, achievements and the future. By completing their profile the young person will increase their self-esteem, improve their motivation, and thereby improve their learning.

S3 Progress Reports

Pupils will receive an S3 progress report in all their subjects. This report will indicate the levels at which they have been working within the Curriculum for Excellence programme and will also indicate the broad level of study in the National Qualification courses that pupils will take in S4. **Please note that these reports will be issued by Friday 8 June 2018.**

Can I remind you that S3 pupils advance into S4 at the start of the new timetable on Wednesday 6 June 2018. There are 3 weeks of S4 before our Activity Week with the summer break coming on 29 June 2018. There will be an S4 Parents Information evening in the 2nd or 3rd week back after the summer holidays at which we will explain the structure of the National Qualification courses in S4. We will inform you of the exact date by letter nearer the time.
