The previous evening we had an excellent social event for parents and former pupils organised by our parent council Nd FP association where former pupil Ronnie Browne, of Corries fame, along with local artist Lyn Handley, unveiled the painting we commissioned of the old school.

The Official Opening of the school is on Wednesday 13th June at which the Minister for Further Education Higher Education and Science will officiate over the opening. In attendance will be local politicians, senior officers of the council, representatives from the parent body, former pupils and people from a range of other community groups.

We are however having every pupil and every member of staff in the school present at the ceremony. It's a great time in the history of our school and it's only right that all in the school are part of it.

Rising School Roll – New 5th House.

Our school role is rising sharply over the next few years.

This year our S1 intake is approximately 270 and this will take the total school role up to 1262.

This necessitates more staff in the school as well as the formation of a 5th House and the introduction of a 5th Pupil Support Leader (PSL).

Mr Peter McIlwaine has been appointed as our 5th PSL and will be the Head of House for Montpelier House. To manage workload for our existing pupil support team, we are redistributing pupil caseloads. This will mean that some pupils will move from their existing house and PSL to the new House and new PSL.

Nobel Prize Winner Visits School

We are very proud to announce that Former pupil Dr Richard Henderson (leaver 1962) is a joint recipient of this year's Nobel prize for Chemistry. We are also delighted that he is coming to visit his old school on Thursday 7th June.

Dr Henderson will tour the new school and then will have lunch with the Head teacher and some staff as well as some former pupils from his year group.

Dr Henderson will then address some 240 senior science pupils about his journey to becoming a Nobel Prize winner in Chemistry before conducting a science master class with about 50 Advanced Higher science pupils.

Dr Henderson will then be our guest of honour at our annual awards ceremony in the evening and as well as making an address to the audience, he will present the Molly T Hope award to the Senior School Champion.

Annual S6 Prom at the Balmoral

Our annual S6 leavers' prom takes place once again at the Balmoral Hotel, Princes Street on Friday 8th June.

It, as always, is a fabulous evening. This year over 200 pupils and staff in formal dress will be piped into dinner by the Boroughmuir pipe band.

After a sumptuous dinner and some speeches, a ceilidh band will play through until midnight!

S5/6 Induction

Our senior pupils return to school on Tuesday 5th June for a day of induction.

In addition to setting out our expectations for senior pupils at Boroughmuir, the induction programme for S6 had a focus on leadership and leadership opportunities in the senior school. S5 spent part of their day at Napier University to give them an insight into what life and education post school could look like and also spent time undertaking practical leadership tasks as well as enrolling for SCHOLAR on-line learning and My World of Work careers advice web-site.

Class teaching starts properly for all on the first day of the new timetable - Wednesday 6th June.

P7 3 Day Visit
