#### National Qualifications Exams

The diet of NQ exams finishes on 31<sup>st</sup> May. I hope pupils in S4, 5 and 6 who were sitting exams are successful in attaining the grades they were aiming for.

The SQA will issue results to pupils this year on August 4<sup>th</sup>. This will be by post or text – whatever the pupil requested. Pupils will receive a letter from Mrs Paterson before the holidays explaining what to do in the event that they perhaps don't meet their target.

# Rising School Roll

Our school roll is rising sharply over the next few years.

This year our S1 intake is approximately 260 and this will take the total school role up to approx. 1300. Our roll will continue to rise over the next 8 years, topping out at about 1660 in 2027

This necessitates more staff in the school as well as more accommodation in the form of an extension. We will keep you updated regularly about this issue.

# <u>Staffing</u>

#### S5/6 Induction

Our senior pupils return to school on Monday 3 June for a day of induction.

In addition to setting out our expectations for senior pupils at Boroughmuir, the induction programme for S6 has a focus on leadership and leadership opportunities in the senior school. S5 spend part of their day at Napier University to give them an insight into what life and education post school could look like. The other part of the day is spent undertaking practical leadership tasks; exploring SCHOLAR and other on-line learning platforms; looking at Career Management Skills and My World of Work; and Office 365.

Class teaching starts proper for all on the first day of the new timetable – Tuesday 4 June.

#### Cluster Transition Activities – March/April/May

We have had a busy few weeks with P7 transition activities. We have had all of our P7 visiting the Art department and creating the "Face of Boroughmuir". Our P6s have been visiting over the last couple of weeks to enjoy some problem solving with the Maths department. Mr Else and some S1 pupils along with the School of Rugby and School of Tennis have invited our P7s for two mornings of sport. Our "May Transition Group" have been visiting too, this is a smaller group of pupils who benefit from some additional visits. This group have been supported by our S1 Nurture Group. Ms Presly, Pupil Support Team along with pupils visited all our Cluster Primaries in one day on 23<sup>rd</sup> April to meet all our P7s.

#### P7 3 Day Visit

A reminder that the P7, shortly to become our new S1, have their 3 day transition experience 18-20<sup>th</sup> June. On Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June pupils meet at Meggetland at 9am for a sports transition event.

On Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June and Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June pupils report to Boroughmuir High School at 9am and 8.32am respectively. Pupils will have a chance to experience some of their new subjects during the 2 days in school as well as experiencing lunchtime clubs and activities.

I look forward to meeting all the new S1 during the 3 day visit and of course parents and carers at the Parents' evening on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June at 7pm in the assembly hall.

#### Activity Week

We have 4 residential trips running this year in activity week involving more than 200 pupils. There are trips to Paris, Spain, Benmore and London. We have week long specialist activities such as "Snow Rock n roll", Film Making, Create and Craft and Bushcraft. Alongside these we offered a broad range of new weekly 'menus' including learning Circus Skills, trips to Botanics, Gravity, Foxlake, Blair Drummond and white-water rafting with Nae Limits and much more. We are very proud of the creativity and enthusiasm of all staff to make this annual event such a success every year.
