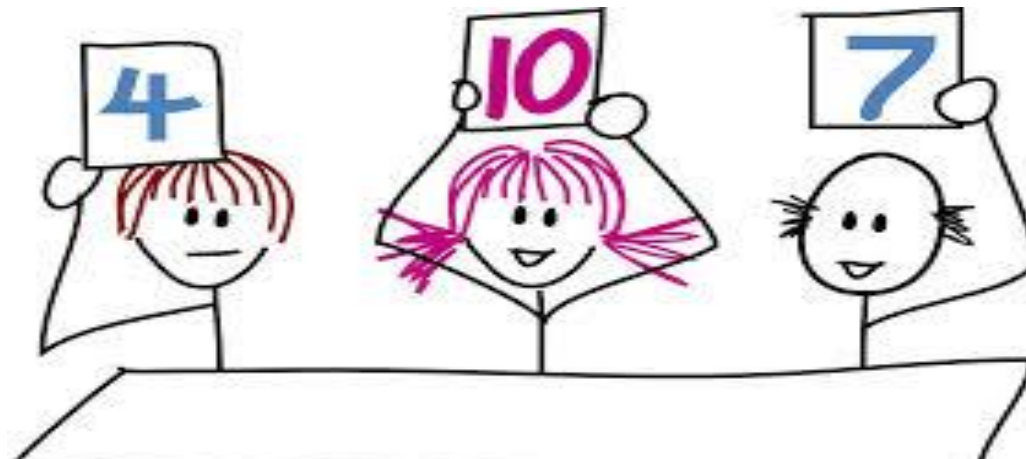
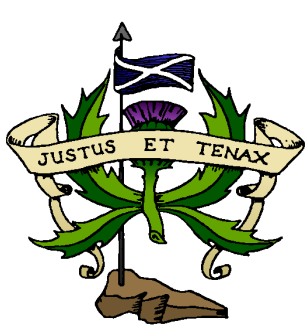

“Cause for Concern”

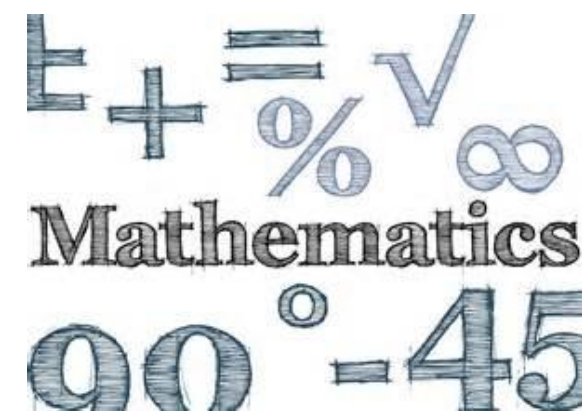
- Internal referral system for any learning, behaviour or welfare concerns
- Picked up by Pupil Support Team
- Interventions if needed – you would be contacted if required



Maths Sets have changed

- Pupils set in maths – many schools do this to best meet pupil needs and ensure the best learning
- These can change – pupils can move up and down to be in the best place for them to achieve their best.
- Based on a range of assessment evidence - by the department and using transition information.
