Amnesty International is a charity who campaign on behalf of people who have had their human rights denied, often for protesting for the human rights of others including the rights of women, LGBTQ+ community, those who oppose authoritarian regimes, and who try to protect the environment. Many are in prison with little chance of release, some tortured, and some have disappeared. Every year Amnesty organises people around the world to campaign to the governments for their freedom, and to send messages of hope, comfort and friendship to those in prison or being oppressed. These letters have a huge impact and have often had people released or saved them from death.
