## Essential Information:

### 1. Assessment Schedule

During the **Revision and Consolidation** blocks all pupils will take part in regular class teaching and revision activities with their normal subject teachers - unless they are undertaking practical assessments.

During the **Assessment Blocks**, when pupils are not engaged in assessments, they will be given the choice to take part in subject-based revision with that subject teacher or revise for any other subject of their choosing.

There is **no traditional 'exam leave'** during this time. Pupil attendance is compulsory, and pupils must remain in timetabled classes at all times. This supported revision time is an essential element for pupils' in their preparation for their assessments.

**Other than in English and Maths, all assessments will take place in class time during a double period.** A detailed daily summary is found on the following pages as is individual subject assessment information.

The assessment schedule has been planned using **subject columns (A-E)**. This will minimise the number of assessments pupils have during this time and reduce the overall number of assessments. The subject-column information for each pupil will be provided by a letter issued to pupils in the w/b Mon 29th March. Class teachers can also provide the subject column information through the TEAMS channels.

Pupils with alternative assessment arrangements (AAA) will be supported throughout this period.

Any set **coursework deadlines must be met** by all pupils.

Pupils **must not share information about assessments** with other pupils in Boroughmuir or from any other school. This will be considered as malpractice and SQA malpractice protocols must be followed. This is to **ensure fairness for all pupils**. Mobile phones are not permitted in classes during any assessment.

As in all years, we aim for pupils to achieve a qualification in each subject studied at the most appropriate level. This sometimes necessitates a change in the level of presentation (Levels offered are usually National 3,4, 5, Higher and Advanced Higher). **Any necessary changes of course level will be discussed and agreed after Assessment Block 1.** This will allow pupils time to complete the necessary assessments at the appropriate levels and ensure the best chance of successful certification.

**All course assessments are mandatory** and must be completed. **Reassessments are not permitted** under SQA protocols.

Exceptional circumstances can be invoked if a pupil is ill on the day of an assessment. In this, case the school must be informed of the absence and it is advisable that a doctor's note is obtained.

## 2. Assessment Marks/Grades

This year the SQA have made it clear that schools must use **demonstrated assessment evidence** in the generation of provisional pupil grades.

This evidence used this year will be the results of the combined assessments in these 2 Assessment Blocks along with any practical marks (applicable in practical subjects) or any applicable folio or project work.

**Schools cannot use 'teachers' professional judgment'** or arbitrary pieces of 'work' to support levels of attainment. In the case of exceptional circumstances or where there are grounds to appeal a grade, other pieces of robust assessment evidence may be drawn on where they exist.

Further information on this process will be provided after Easter.
