- •Similarly, pupils who may not succeed at Nat 4 can complete Nat 3 assessment to use as evidence and if necessary these pupils will receive retrospective certification at Nat 3.

External assessment	Paper 1: read passage and answer questions showing understanding and analysis of language used Paper 2: write one critical essay and answer questions on an extract from a Scottish text studied during the course.
