- The school will only contact you at this time if we feel there are concerns we need to discuss with you
- There will be an opportunity to discuss your son/daughter's progress with subject teachers at the S5/6 Parent/Carer consultation on Thursday 2 February 2017 (Hartington/Leamington) or Tuesday 7 February 2017(Viewforth/Westhall)
- The next target grade has been set by the teacher following a conversation with your son/daughter.
- The working grade has been given by the class teacher based on work done in August/September. The degree of difficulty of the work at this stage in the course is taken into account by the class teacher when awarding the grade which is in line with SQA grades as shown below.
- The target grade and working grade may change as pupils progress through their courses.
