


BOROUGHMUIR HIGH SCHOOL S1 & S6 SPONSORED WALK FRIDAY 14th October 2016

WHO? All S1 and S6 pupils are expected to take part.

WHERE? Walking the High Road round Holyrood Park, past Dunsapie Loch towards St Margaret's Loch and back to The Hawse.

WHY? To raise money for the S6 Prom and The Royal Hospital for Sick Children.

HOW? S6 pupils will meet at the Hawse on Holyrood Park which is at the roundabout near the entrance to the park at Pollock Halls. Pupils should be at the Hawse by 11.00am. Pupils do not need to come into school beforehand.

DRESS? Pupils are expected to wear comfortable clothing e.g.

- Tracksuit bottoms
- Trainers
- T shirt (Boroughmuir badged PE t-shirts can be worn)
- Jumper (Boroughmuir badged hoodies can be worn)
- Waterproof essential
- Sun cream if necessary

Pupils should bring water with them. Pupils may accessorise with house colours.
