S5 <u>Nuffield Research Placements:</u> Boroughmuir has assisted students with their applications in recent years. On Tues 8<sup>th</sup> Nov at Lunch (1pm) Lab 313 (Mr Hembury's lab) there will be a short meeting where more information can be obtained.

The Nuffield Research Placements offer over 1000 bursaries a year, for students who have an interest in studying Science, Technology, Engineering and/or Maths (STEM) subjects at Higher (e.g. Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Maths, Geography, Computing, Home Economics/Food Technology, Psychology, Music Technology, Product Design, Technological Studies etc.). This is also applicable for those interested in Social Sciences. Projects are 4-6 weeks in length and take place during the summer holidays, giving an insight into the world of research and development. You could be eligible to apply for a bursary of approx **£100 per week** to support them during their project. Placements are available in Edinburgh and the local regions, in universities, industry or research institutions. The closing date is on Feb 24th 2017.
