

## **University Entrance**

- Scottish Universities 4/5 Higher passes by the end of S5 (1st sitting)
- Additional passes at Higher in S6 if minimum not met in S5
- Some Scottish Universities may set conditions on Advanced Highers if the S5 conditions are not met. Completion of AH is very important
- English Universities require 2 or 3 Advanced Highers in addition to 4/5 good Higher passes in S5





### **Higher English**

- Exam (70% of grade):
  - Paper 1 RUAE (30 marks)
  - Paper 2 Critical Reading 1 Scottish textual analysis (20 marks) + critical essay (20 marks)
- Folio of Writing (30% of grade):
  - editing Discursive / persuasive piece
  - drafting first personal-reflective, or creative, piece
- Spoken Language continued assessment of four elements of Spoken Language Course Award, through solo and group talk. Must be passed by end of March to gain a course award



- Deadline was the 9<sup>th</sup> February so forms should be returned ASAP
- It takes around 12 weeks for DWY to process placements and carry out Health and Safety checks
