The letter sent to you recently from NHS also asked for your help:

- Limit gatherings and avoid car sharing
- Close contacts to isolate and get tested
- Symptoms get tested and isolate

We are also pleased that outdoor extracurricular activities will be able to resume from 26th April. There will be important safety considerations to be met and your Headteacher will let you know what they are and when clubs are starting in your school. We are not yet able to restart indoor extracurricular activities, unfortunately, but will keep you updated should that change.

Finally, the end of the summer term is normally a time for transitions and celebrations. While these are not possible in their usual format this year, we are making every attempt to make safe alternative arrangements. Should there be further changes to the national and local protection levels, we will reflect those in our plans and guidance.
