

P7 – S1 Transition

January – March

 BHS SFL staff can attend Child Planning Meetings if there is a particular concern around the transition

April

- BHS SFL staff and Pupil Support Leaders visit catchment primary schools to meet with P7 class teachers and SFL staff
- Ms Presly and S6 pupils meet with all P7 pupils

May

• Enhanced Transition – 4 weekly sessions which give pupils that chance to meet teachers and work across all curricular areas

June

- Three day visit
- Day 1 Meggatland
- Day 2 Boroughmuir High School
- Day 3 Boroughmuir High School

SFL staff spend the day at Meggatland

PSA's move between different classes during the two days in school to observe pupils and to work with those who we know may need support.

Role of PSA

- Support pupils to access the curriculum by working with pupils in class
- Supervise pupils in the Hub at break time
- Support Nurture Groups
- Accompany pupils on trips
- Liaise with, class teachers, SFL teaching staff and Pupil Support Leaders
- Support pupils with any assessments

- Transitions are important in a child's life


Nurture at BHS


- Pupil Support Officer /School Nurse trained
- 6/7 week program 1 period a week
- Led & monitored by CAMHs psychologist
- Pupils who see themselves as having unmanageable worry/anxiety
- Over 10 pupils trained across all year groups





SRA Corrective Reading Programme

- All CEC secondary schools have been centrally supported to resource this programme.
- Structured phonics programme.
- Well researched and evidenced locally and nationally.
- We aim to deliver the programme twice a week, in a small group setting.
- Groups are established based on SWRT scores and SRA placement tests.




Homework Club
