Bullying behaviours may include:

- Name calling, teasing, putting down or threatening
- Ignoring, leaving out or spreading rumours
- Hitting, tripping, kicking
- Taking and damaging belongings
- Sending an abusive message, or posting an abusive comment online
- Making people feel like they are being bullied
- Targeting someone because of who they are or who they are perceived to be. This may include racism, sexism, disability or homophobia, as well as differences in socio-economic background
- Online bullying will not be treated any differently. We will address online bullying in the same way as the behaviours described above
