










16 years old by 30 September 2022:

• eligible to leave school in May 2022

16 years old by end of February 2023:

 Must remain in full time education at school or college until December 2022 (can look at work experience and college courses as alternative to school)

Key point is to speak to guidance teacher if thinking of leaving so that we can offer support and guidance and put pupils in touch with Skills Development Scotland (SDS)

#### **Higher/National Courses**

#### Each course consists of:

- Course work/assignment worth percentage of course (these have been amended by SQA over past few years)
- •Examination externally assessed in May 2023

Course work + Exam = Course Award



#### e.g. Higher English

- Exam (70% of grade):
  - Paper 1 RUAE (30 marks)
  - Paper 2 Critical Reading 1 Scottish textual

analysis (20 marks) + critical essay (20 marks)

- Folio of Writing (30% of grade):
  - editing Discursive / persuasive piece
  - drafting first personal-reflective, or creative, piece
- Spoken Language continued assessment of four elements of Spoken Language Course Award, through solo and group talk. Must be passed by end of March to gain a course award



#### **Structure of the Senior School**

28 period week

- 5 subjects (5 hours per week)
- Column E 2 double periods (Tue/Thu)
- 3 periods:
  - PSE
  - Career Management Skills Rota
  - Study period (We hope to be able to offer optional PE during this time)



## **College Courses - SCP**

- Travel Column Period 1 on a Monday in school
  Period 5 & 6 on Tuesday + Thursday at college
- Check where course is taking place can you get there?
- Bus tokens provided
- Good way of getting experience of college before leaving school
- Highers/Nat 5/Foundation Apprenticeships
- Must apply for College courses now- August is too late CHECK ENTRY REQUIREMENTS!!

- Please note these courses may be online learning for session 2022-23 please make back up choice for school



### **Course Choice Process**

# What to consider when choosing subjects...

- 8 subjects → 5 subjects
  (x3 periods/wk) (x5 periods/wk)
- Workload
- Ensure pupil meets entry requirements (in course choice booklet)
- Progression avoid 'crashing'
- Play to strengths the progression statistics for courses are available on the SQA website <u>https://www.sqa.org.uk/sqa/91419.html</u>



#### **Process of Course Choice**

- Course Choice booklet and information issued
- SE Check in with guidance teacher
- Friday 25 Feburary Final choices made online (remember to choose your subjects in order of preference)
- Online applications made to college online by <u>18</u>
  <u>March</u>
- Courses confirmed June all courses require viable numbers in order to run
- Re-course if necessary in August
