The S2 contact for Support for Learning is Mrs Hall (<u>sarah.hall@boroughmuir.edin.sch.uk</u>). The Support for Learning Department also run the Homework Club. This is held on Wednesdays after school in the library with staff available to offer study support advice, support with Office 365 and they provide snacks!

Our new Our Wellbeing Hub (WBH) is designed to meet specific wellbeing needs of individual pupils with a focus on supporting social interactions, improving self-confidence/self-esteem, and supporting those experiencing anxiety and/or emotional regulation. Pupils who attend the WBH do so for a short period following a referral and the production of an agreed individual plan and targets.

# **School Extension**

Although delayed the school extension is making progress and we hope to be able to use the new classrooms later this school year. We have now opened the refurbished classrooms LG09, which is now an IT space, and LG10 which is now a 3<sup>rd</sup> kitchen.

# School Improvement Plan (SIP)

We had a productive professional learning session with our primary school colleagues on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> August. A written report will be issued to you in the first week in March, prior to the online Parent Consultation Evening on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> March.
