Study support

We are now busy with final preparations for qualifications this summer. As usual there is a huge range of support available and we expect students to lead their own learning by organising themselves to attend as much as possible.

1. Students have been given a variety of study support advice. Students should have created a **revision success plan** for the remaining weeks until exams. These are all available on ipads/Teams/ Assignments or from PSE teachers.
2. Departments continue to offer **study support sessions** around the school day. Teachers go out of their way to offer these and we hope students make the most of these. 3. Over **Easter** there is a fantastic programme of **webinars** which we strongly recommend. 4. Students in S4 who have 3 or fewer exams will have a programme of in-school study to support them to complete their internally assessed qualifications. They will get a timetable for this.
5. All other students will have **study leave**. This begins on Monday 24th April and continues until Tuesday 30th May. The new timetable will start on Wednesday 31st May. During study leave students can arrange to come in to meet a teacher but **MUST sign in at the office and go straight to the relevant classroom.**
6. There is also a programme of '**immersion days**'. These help to give structure to your study and a chance to access specialist help in the final days before an exam. The outline timetable is below but you should check with your teachers when and where these are. You may have to sign up so that departments can manage numbers.

Well done to all our senior students for the hard work that you are putting in. Keep asking for help if you need it and we look forward to your well-deserved results in the summer.
