Our green (badge embroidered) t-shirts are supplied by **Stevensons** in a cotton material. Also available is a branded (Canterbury) and sportier version of these t-shirts with an embroidered badge.

Our green (badge embroidered) t-shirts in a 'Clima Cool' material are also supplied by **Football Nation**

School embroidered t-shirts are however not compulsory.

School Hoodies

These should not replace blazers but rather complement them.

There are two versions of the school hoodie – the standard hoodie and the sports hoodie. Both are Boroughmuir green in colour.

These are approved by the school and are similar but the sports version is a branded (Canterbury) more fitted hoodie.

We believe that Boroughmuir High School pupils are clearly identifiable in Edinburgh by the distinctive green hoodie.

Hoodies can be worn in class but a shirt and tie are still required to be worn. They are ideal outerwear for sporting events or for wearing when representing the school at a range of informal events.

Hoodies are not compulsory.

What are the benefits of a school dress code?

We believe that there are many advantages for pupils, for schools and for parents in having a clear dress code.

- Encouraging a sense of belonging and pride in the school
- Encouraging a purposeful attitude to school work and extra-curricular activities enhancing the image of the school in the community
- Discouraging competition between pupils (regarding designer wear, for example)
- Discouraging bullying and victimisation which may arise from pupils not having certain clothing or footwear
- Improving safety in the classroom and in practical areas such as science labs
- Improving school security through easy identification of intruders
- Improving security on excursions through the easy identification of pupils.



School Policy

Boroughmuir High School will encourage pupils to wear school dress by working closely with parents, pupils and Parent Council. The school will remind pupils and parents of the school dress code in assemblies, newsletters, the school prospectus and regularly in the school bulletin.

The school depute heads will:

- Speak to the pupil and ask him/her to follow the dress code and support the school policy.
- Contact parents by letter or by telephone to encourage pupils to follow the school

Footwear and Clothing Grants

Grants for footwear and clothing for children are available to parents receiving:

- Child Tax Credit, but not Working tax credit, with an annual income of less than £17,005
- Both Child Tax Credit and Working Tax Credit and have an income of up to £7,920
- Income Support
- Jobseekers Allowance [income-based]
- Universal Credit (monthly earned income not more than £660)
- Income related element of Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999

What is the school dress code?

Daily Dress Code

- **Formal black skirt/trousers**
- **Formal white shirt**
- **Black V neck jumper**
- **S1-4 Boroughmuir striped tie**
- **S5-6 Boroughmuir crested tie**
- **Formal black shoes**
- **Black Blazer integral for S1-6**

- ◇ Black jeans are not part of the dress code
- ◇ Black leggings are not part of the dress code
- ◇ Formal shirts should be buttoned up
- ◇ Coloured t-shirts should not be worn or be visible beneath shirts
- ◇ Ties should be worn properly

Ties

Ties are available to buy via Parent Pay at a cost of £3.00 (S1-4) and £5.00 S5 and S6). They are now available from **Stevensons** also.

Blazers

Blazers are now an integral part of the dress code for S1-6 pupils. As such we expect blazers to be worn by pupils every day.

We also have embroidered badges priced at £3.00 which can be purchased via Parent Pay. These are available if you chose to purchase a black blazer from an alternative supplier.
