Online tuition

We very highly recommend esgoil (also available on clickview), Achieve, and Scholar. The logins are below.

- **Esgoil** is the Scottish government's online help and offers regular, live, online support for most subjects. You have to sign up for their webinars here:

 - o Pupils will require their Glow username and password which will be group called to them, or they can get from Ms Braisby.
- **ClickView** is a very useful video resource store, particularly the West OS online school partnership. West OS has produced free online content for National 5 and Higher Courses to support and help with learning and revision. Content can be accessed here:

 - o Pupils are required to log in to ClickView. This is their Office365 username and password.
