Online tuition

We very highly recommend esgoil (also available on clickview), Achieve, and Scholar. The logins are below.

- **Esgoil** is the Scottish government's online help and offers regular, live, online support for most subjects. You have to sign up for their webinars here:

- **ClickView** is a very useful video resource store, particularly the West OS online school partnership. West OS has produced free online content for National 5 and Higher Courses to support and help with learning and revision. Content can be accessed here:

 - Pupils are required to log in to ClickView. This is their Office365 username and password.
- **Scholar** is Heriot Watt University's offer of online courses aligned with 42 National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher Level SQA courses. The programme provides notes, key points, activities, tests and quizzes that offer instant feedback. Content can be accessed here:
