Course choice evening for S4 – and study skills event for S3s and S4s

S2 Course Choice

On Wednesday, 29th January, we will be holding an S2 Course Choice Information Evening from 6-8pm. This event is for obtaining general subject information. It is not an opportunity to discuss any individual child's course choices. The format will be:

- 6pm-7.15pm: Subject Marketplace (Atrium)
- 7.15pm-8pm: Parent Presentation (Assembly Hall)

We politely request that pupils do not attend the presentations due to potential capacity limitations within the Assembly Hall. Pupils are welcome to wait in the Atrium.

<u>S3 Assessments – April/May 2025 (repeat from last week)</u>

We have started discussing next term's S3 Assessments with S3s in Assembly and in the PSE classes. S3 Assessments will start after the Easter Holiday and are scheduled over a number of weeks. They provide an important opportunity for S3s to prepare for future S4 prelims (practice exams), which usually take place in November 2025. Unlike the S4 prelims, these S3 assessments are completed under the supervision of regular class teachers and during normal lesson times. S3 assessments typically cover much of the course knowledge, understanding, and skills from the start of S3.

There is a slightly different schedule based on Registration classes, which are grouped as either 3R1-3R5 or 3R6-3R10. We will be supporting pupils with their revision over the coming weeks. The draft assessment schedule is found here.
