## **Boroughmuir High School Dress Code**

We ask all pupils to identify with the school, but they can have personalisation and choice with regards how they do this.

Pupils in S1-S6	
Personalisation and choice	All pupils must wear
	A white shirt.
Plain black jumper <b>Or</b>	A school tie. In S6 pupils are asked to wear the S6 tie.
A school branded hoodie  And/or  A school blazer	Plain black bottoms with no logo.
A scrioor brazer	Black (black and white if all black is not an option) shoes or trainers.

Pupils should bring appropriate clothing for the activity they are working on. Activities can be indoor and outdoor so preparing for the weather is important.

PE clothes should be different from those worn to school. During PE lessons all jewellery must be removed and long hair tied back.
